ADMISSION TO BAMS COURSE UNDER NRI/NRI SPONSORED QUOTA FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2023-24

SPECIAL NOTE TO NRI / NRI SPONSORED CANDIDATES.

NRI quota includes Overseas Citizens of India (OCI) and Persons of Indian Origin (PIO).

Eligibility for NRI / NRI Sponsored Quota:

a) At least one of the parents of the student should be an NRI and shall ordinarily be residing abroad as an NRI.

OR

b) The person who sponsors the student for admission should be a first degree relation of the student and should be ordinarily residing abroad as an NRI.

The first degree relation should be any of these:

i) Real brother and sister of father i.e. real uncle and real aunt.

ii) Real brother and sister of mother i.e. real maternal uncle and maternal aunt.

iii) Father and mother of father i.e. grandfather and grandmother.

iv) Father and mother of mother i.e. maternal grandfather and maternal grandmother.

v) First degree-paternal and maternal cousins.

c) If the student has no parents or near relatives or taken as a ward by some other nearest relative such students also may be considered for admission provided the guardian has bonafide treated the student as a ward and such guardian shall file an affidavit indicating the interest shown in the affairs of the student and also his relationship with the student and such person also should be an NRI, and ordinarily residing abroad.

Seats:

Total number of seats - **09** (Nine)

Eligibility Conditions:

For admission to the course, the candidate should fulfill the necessary admission requirements for the respective degree courses, as prescribed by the Pondicherry University

- a) The students seeking admission to BAMS course are required to qualify the NEET and secure the minimum required marks.
- b) Candidates seeking admission for B.A.M.S. course must have passed in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology & English individually and must have obtained a minimum marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the qualifying examination with a minimum of 50% marks for General and 45% of marks for OBC / BCM / MBC / EBC / OPH (General &OBC) and 40% of marks for SC / ST / BT & OPH.
- c) The Higher Secondary Examination or the Indian School Certificate Examination which is equivalent to10 +2 Higher Secondary Examination after a period of 12 years study, the last two years of study comprising of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and Mathematics or any other elective subjects with English at a level not less than core course of English as prescribed by the National Council of Educational Research and Training after the introduction of 10+2+3 years educational structure as recommended by the National Committee on Education.

Criteria for selection:

The selection of candidates shall be based on the merit list prepared on the basis NEET score. In case of a tie, the marks in the optional subjects viz., Botany, Zoology, Physics and Chemistry shall be taken into consideration and in case of further tie, the age of the candidate shall be taken into consideration and the older candidates shall be given preference.

Hostel facility (For Girls only):

▶ Hostel facility will be provided as per availability.

2) Fees payable to the University:

Registration fee, Matriculation fee, Recognition fee, University development fee and sports fee shall be payable at the rate as prescribed by the Pondicherry University at the time of admission.

3) Examination fee

Shall be payable as prescribed by the University.

4) Hostel fees and other deposits

If a student discontinues the course on or before the last date of counseling of the year of admission he / she shall have to pay **Rs.50,000/-** and in case the candidate leaves the institute after completing the admission procedure of the competent authority or during any other subsequent academic years, he / she shall have to pay a sum of **Rs. 2,00,000/-** as penalty (separate agreement bond should be signed by the candidate and parent / guardian along with two sureties aforesaid, which is available with the institute).

APPLICATION FEE:

US \$ 15 or INR 1,000/- in the form of a bank draft / cash/ cheque drawn from a nationalized bank in favour of THE PRINCIPAL, RAJIV GANDHI AYURVEDA MEDICAL COLLEGE, MAHE, payable at Mahe.

The list of documents to be submitted for NRI / NRI Sponsored Quota are as below:

- (a) Documents claiming that the sponsor is an NRI (Copy of the Passport, VISA of the sponsor should be attached)
- (b) Relationship of NRI with the candidate as per the definition above should be indicated.
- (c) Notarised Affidavit from the sponsor that he/she will sponsor the entire course fee of the candidate
- (d) Embassy Certificate of the Sponsor (Certificate from the Consulate)
- (e) NEET Scorecard.
- (f) Birth Certificate/Proof of Date of birth
- (g) Higher Secondary (10+2) or Equivalent Examination Mark Sheet
- (h) Transfer Certificate/Migration Certificate issued by the Head of the Institute/University last attended (whichever is applicable)
- (i) Bonafide/Conduct Certificate issued by the Head of Institution last attended
- (j) Medical fitness Certificate

Note:

- Candidates are required to read the PROSPECTUS thoroughly before applying.
- The selected candidates under NRI/NRI Sponsored will be treated on par with regular students. No special amenities or facilities will be provided.
- The Institution will not own the responsibility of the applicant's involvement in any unlawful activities during the period of study and he/she is solely responsible to appear for any enquiry from the police and any competent authority.
- The candidates admitted under this quota are not eligible for any reimbursement of fee or any other educational concessions offered by the Government.
- > The college will be allotted based on merit as per availability of seats.
- ➢ Furnishing of any false information in the application will result in cancellation of admission.
- All the rules and regulations governing UG programmes will apply to the candidates selected under NRI/NRI sponsored quota also.
- > Fees once paid shall not be refunded under any circumstances.
- > Candidates shall have to attend to the certificate verification at their own cost.
- > The Institution does not guarantee any employment to the candidates.
- > The Institution is not responsible for the information provided in other websites.
- Parents and Students are informed that the admissions are purely based on merit and guidelines of the University and Govt. of Puducherry/India.
- > The parents and candidates should regularly visit the official website www.rgamc.in for any further information.

SELECTION

The order of selection is as follows:

- 1) Preference will be given to the NRI sponsored candidates of Puducherry UT. (Certificate form Revenue authorities to be submitted for claiming the quota)
- 2) NRI candidates of other state.
- 3) NRI sponsored candidates of other states.
- 4) Foreign candidates.

In case of tie of marks, the tie will be resolved by eliminating the marks in the following order:

Physics, Chemistry, Biology.

Even if the tie persists thereafter, the Date of Birth will be taken into account i.e. one who was born earlier will get precedence over the one born later.

Display of Merit List

The common merit list for the selected candidates will be displayed in the Institute Website and also on the notice board of the college campus. No separate announcement will be made in the newspaper or communication sent to the candidates separately.

Counseling for Admission

The Counseling and allotment of seats will be conducted at Rajiv Gandhi Ayurveda Medical College & Hospital, Mahe campus. Candidates **shall be called for counseling as per their merit through call letters/e mail. No change of date or time of counseling is permitted on any circumstances.** The Institute shall not be responsible for any postal delay. Counseling will not be done in absence of the candidate. Candidates who do not attend the counseling on the specified date and time will have to forego the claim of admission.

The date and time for the counseling (Schedule) will be published in the institute website, and individual call letters will be sent to the candidates.

Submission of original certificates

The original certificates submitted by the candidate during admission shall be returned only after completion of the Course. If in the event of discontinuation of the Course, the original Certificates will be returned as per the regulations of the Institute. Hence the candidates are advised to take enough number of photocopies of the certificates before submitting the originals. Verification of original certificates

Candidates called for counseling shall be required to submit all the certificates **in original** for verification at the time of counseling. Candidates who fail to produce the required certificate in original shall not be considered. However, if a candidate has deposited the original Certificates to an institution where he/she has already been admitted, a letter / bonafide certificate to that effect issued by the Head of the Institution should be produced. In such cases, the self-attested copies of certificates will be considered for verification, subject to production of all original certificates including Transfer Certificate within the time specified by the Admission Committee.

The following documents should be **attached along with filled application.**

NRI candidates

- I. Certified copy of the grade equivalent to marks of Board of Schools.
- II. Copy of passport.
- III. Proof of NRI status of the student / parents / sponsor.

NRI sponsored candidates

- I. Copy of NRI bank account passbook of the sponsor.
- II. Copy of Passport of the sponsor.
- III. Nativity certificate of the sponsor.

The following certificates should be produced at the time of joining

- 1) Certificate of the Qualifying Examination with mark sheet.
- 2) Birth certificate.
- 3) Transfer Certificate & Conduct certificate from the Institution last studied.
- 4) Photocopies of the first page of the passport and also the visa to enter the country (Student visa, PIO Card or OCI card).
- 5) SSLC/Equivalent certificate
- 6) Passport size photographs (colour) of the student -4nos.
- 7) Certificate showing the proof for blood relationship (for NRI sponsored candidate.)
- 8) Proof of NRI status of student/parents/guardian.
- 9) Medical Certificate in case of OPH candidate.
- 10) The Memorandum sent to the Candidate by the Institution.
- 11) NRI status certificate of the sponsor issued by the Embassy/Consulate of the respective country under seal and signature.
